1. In line with the implementation of the rationalization of DepED, which calls for a higher level of responsibility, accountability, and supervisory functions among RFTATs in the provision of Technical Assistance (TA) to Schools Divisions, in order to facilitate the delivery of quality basic education and create an enabling environment for School-Based Management (SBM) and "ACCESS" program, this office has come up with a new composition and assignment of RFTATs.

  - d. explain the mode of providing technical assistance to them.
4. In this connection, you are advised to give priority to the RFTATs' monthly visit and make the focal persons of the Curriculum and Instruction Division (CID) and School Governance and Operation Division (SGOD) available during the above schedule.
