September is considered the **National Science Clubs Month (NSCM)** under Presidential Proclamation No. 264. During the NSCM, the **Philippine Society of Youth Science Clubs (PSYSC)** conducts activities that encourage the youth to actively participate in the science clubbing movement. Through these activities, PSYSC aims to provide a venue for the interaction of science clubs and to recognize excellence through workshops and friendly competitions. The three (3) main events that will kick-off this year's NSCM are the **National Science Clubs Summit (SUMMIT)**, **PSYSC Science Olympiad (PSO)**, and **I Teach Science Seminar (ITSS)**.



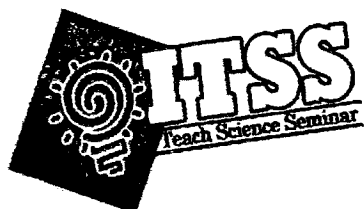
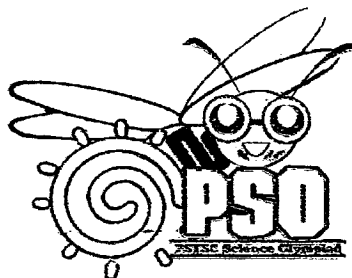
Date: September 6-7, 2014

The **National Science Clubs Summit (SUMMIT)** is a one and a half-day gathering of high school science club affiliates, conducted simultaneously in different regions. The event is an opportunity for the different science clubs to learn from lectures, workshops, and plenary session. The SUMMIT brings the camp experience closer to our affiliates who are not able to attend the **National Youth Science Technology and Environment Summer Camp (NYSTESC)**. Exciting trademark activities of SUMMIT include Sub-camp Quiz Competition and fun-filled Science workshops. SUMMIT also offers the chance to experience **MathSciAKA**, a event which provides set of interactive workshops.



The **Philippine Society of Youth Science Club Science Olympiad (PSO)** is an inter-school quiz competition for elementary and high school students all over the country. This Olympiad consists of two rounds: (1) the **National Eliminations**, conducted simultaneously in different regions, which will be a written exam that will challenge the students' knowledge on various science categories, and (2) the **National Finals**, which will be composed of theoretical and practical rounds. Prizes would include cash, plaques, medals and certificates.

The **I Teach Science Seminar (ITSS)** is a half-day activity catering to science teachers of affiliated schools. It is an enrichment seminar packed with lectures, workshops, and discussions for teachers featuring ways on how they can make science teaching fun and interactive. This is PSYSC's way of thanking the teachers for the service they bring to the youth and as well as to the organization.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

WHO AND HOW CAN I JOIN?

Only science clubs currently (as of September 2014) affiliated with PSYSC can join all the activities for NSCM. For science clubs whose affiliation will expire on or before September 2014 and those who are not affiliated, please refer to the Affiliation Brochure and Guidelines. To join, each school should pass on or before August 22, 2014 the registration requirements listed below either through email to psysc.nscm2014@gmail.com or mail to the following address:

- 1. Proof of Affiliation** - for non-affiliates who will affiliate with PSYSC.
- 2. Form 3** - the registration form included in the envelope
 - a. Submission is PER SCHOOL. Fill all details asked completely. Check all activities that you will join. For SUMMIT, PSO and ITSS, check the site where you want to participate (preferably choose the region where your school is located).
 - b. If joining SUMMIT and ITSS, indicate the number of participants in the appropriate box. Also check YES or NO if you will avail the food of the school canteen.
 - c. For the Payment Details, check what mode you have paid the registration fee. Also indicate in the box provided the amount paid for the SUMMIT and ITSS registration fee.
 - d. For the Letter of Endorsement, let the Principal or School Head and the Science Club Advisor sign at the provided space. Make sure that all students are physically fit and allowed by their parents or guardian to join any NSCM activity.
 - e. A Registration Requirements Checklist is provided for you as a guide.
- 3. List of Participants**
 - a. For those who will email the Registration Requirements, an Excel file with the proper format can be downloaded at the www.nscm2014.org. We will also provide a link to other PSYSC web portals: psysc.org, www.facebook.com/psysc, www.facebook.com/psysc.nscm. Fill-up the information asked completely. We HIGHLY ENCOURAGE sending a softcopy in excel file to psysc.nscm2014@gmail.com.
 - b. For those who will submit through mail, a hardcopy may be laxed by the National Office. You may also opt to make your own document file following the format below. It is already filled up to serve as an example. Add more rows to add more participants. Print the list and mail along with the other registration requirements.

A. **Proof of Payment with breakdown:** For SUMMIT and ITSS only. The deposit slip of the payment (either original or photocopy) or the copy of the postal money order (PMO).

Attach all files in a single email with the following subject: **<School Name> NSCM 2014 Registration Requirements**. Ex: **Paulina National High School NSCM 2014 Registration Requirements**. Each file attached should be named with **<School Name> <File Type>**. Ex: **Paulina National High School FORM 3**. For payment through PMO, send it to the address above. **Incomplete Registration Requirements and forms with incomplete details or not following the given format will NOT BE ACCEPTED.**

• Slips are given out on a first-come, first-served basis. The school should immediately notify PSYSC on the day of payment. The date of notification will be considered as the date of registration. Notification can be done by email, by phone or by fax. When not notified the day in which the Landbank deposit slip or PMO slip is received by PSYSC will be the basis for the day in which the school registered, depending on the availability of slots.

HOW MUCH IS THE REGISTRATION FEE?

There is NO registration fee for the PSYSC Science Olympiad, SUMMIT-Maths/CIKA and Math/CIKA. The SUMMIT registration fee is Php 750 per participant for PSYSC affiliates who will register on or before August 22, 2014. Registration fee for walk-in participants from affiliated schools and affiliates who will register after August 22, 2014 is Php 500 per participant. For non-affiliates who still want to join, the registration fee is Php 1000 per participant. Walk-ins will only be accepted depending on the available slots.

Note: Payment of Php 150 as pre-registration fee per participant will be allowed, the remaining balance of Php 100 must be paid during the registration on site. Payment can either be made through:

- a. Landbank of the Philippines: Account No. 0702-1020-65; or
- b. Postal Money Order (PMO) payable to: Philippine Society of Youth Science Clubs
