Pursuant to Presidential Proclamation No. 675 dated July 20, 2004 entitled *Declaring the Month of September 2004 and Every Year Thereafter as the National Peace Consciousness Month*, the Department of Education (DepEd) announces the celebration of the **2014 National Peace Consciousness Month** this September with the theme *Nagkakaisang Bayan Para Sa Kapayapaan*. The Office of the Presidential Adviser on the Peace Process (OPAPP) has been mandated to spearhead the annual celebration of National Peace Consciousness Month since September 2004 and every year thereafter.

- b. Recitation of the **Harmony Prayer** and **Pledge for Peace** (copies enclosed), during flag raising ceremonies for the month of September, and delivery of the peace message by the esteemed OPAPP Secretary highlighting the Peace Month theme this year;
- c. Participation in the activities lined up for the Peace Month Celebration; and
- d. Undertaking the Peace Month activities in line with the DepEd's mandate and the Peace Month theme, or include the theme and message of peace in the scheduled activities for September to encourage DepEd officials, employees, teachers, students and pupils to show solidarity for Peace.
