THREE-DAY LIVE-OUT FOLK DANCE WORKSHOP FOR TEACHERS

1. In line with the cultural development program of this Division, this Office announces the conduct of a Three-Day Live-Out Folk Dance Workshop for teachers on October 9, 10, 11, 2014 at Dalaguete Sports Complex for the South Area and on October 16, 17, 18, 2014 for the North Area at Panphil Frasco Gym (former KAI Gym), Liloan, Cebu.
2. This workshop aims to enrich teacher's skills and competencies necessary in teaching folkdances to pupils/students and capacitate them to effectively and efficiently contribute to the implementation of the cultural development program in the Division.
3. From the folkdances taught in the workshop, contest piece for the Folkdance Competition, in the Elementary and Secondary levels, in the upcoming Provincial Sports and Cultural Festival shall be determined.
4. Participants to the workshop are elementary and secondary teachers in the public and private schools and folkdance enthusiasts who are physically fit to undergo strenuous activities. No pregnant participant shall be allowed.
5. Those participants living far from the venue may arrange from the nearest school for their accommodation at night.
6. A registration fee of Php 300.00 shall be charged each participant to defray expenses for handouts and dance literature, CDs to contain the music of the dances taught, certificates, honoraria of resource persons and other operating expenses necessary for the conduct of the workshop. Registration, transportation, and other expenses incurred by the participants from the public schools on account of their participation maybe charged to local school MOOE/SEF/PTA or any funds subject to their availability and the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Participants from the private schools can make arrangements with the administration of their respective schools on matters relative to participation expenses.
7. Participants are to come to the workshop in P. E. or any comfortable attire and rubber/flat shoes. However, norms of decency appropriate for educators should be observed in the choice of comfortable attire (i.e. no short pants, spaghetti strapped or tube blouses and the like shall be allowed.
8. Wide dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
