**A. School Heads Development Program: Specialized Course for School Heads of Senior High School**

1. The National Educators Academy of the Philippines commends the Regional Offices and the Human Resource Development Division (HRDD) for the successful conduct of the School Heads' Development Program: Specialized Course for School Heads of Senior High School (SHDP-SHS).
2. All SHDP-SHS participants are requested to personally answer an online survey. The objectives of this are the following: (1) to identify the program's areas of strength and areas for improvement (2) to gather feedback on how the program affected the school heads (3) to capture practices in preparation for Senior High School.     - i. passed the regional qualifying examination for Principals before 2008 without NEAP accredited training
    - ii. are not yet Principal's Test passers
