Corrigendum to Division Memo No. 678 Entitled School Heads Induction Program (SHIP) 2016 Dated October 21, 2016

1. Based on the list/s of participants submitted from the respective school/s districts, the Division Office consolidated around 220 school/s heads who are newly-hired and/or with less than three years in their current position.
2. Since the training team wanted to have a **competency-based/outcomes-based training**, the office decided to divide the **2016 School Heads Induction (SHIP)** into two batches.
3. The first batch will be on **November 7-11, 2016** with the participants starting from **Abarca, Cristina B. (TIC of Santander)** up to **Montemayor, Nolan M. (HT1 of Aloguinsan)**. Please refer to the attachment of **Div. Memo No. 678, s. 2016 (in alphabetical order)**.
4. Opening program will be at DepEd Ecotech Pavilion on **November 7, 2016** at around **12:30PM**. After the opening program, the participants will be divided into two groups: participants **Abarca, Cristina B. up to Domugho, Elezabeth D. (HT1 of Moalboal)** will stay at Ecotech Pavilion (**75 pax**) while participants from **Duazo, Lindley S. (TIC of Barili 2) up to Montemayor, Nolan M. (HT 1 of Aloguinsan)** will be at **Room Narra 2 (50 pax)**. Please refer to the original listing in alphabetical order.

5. Participants starting from Monzales, Roel (HT1 of Tabogon) up to Zurita, Zandro (TIC of Poro) will attend the next batch on the date/schedule that will be announced later in a separate memo.

6. Newly-appointed school heads/TIC's who are not in the original list as attached to Div. Memo 678, s. 2016 may join the second batch provided that the district supervisors concerned will submit an updated list.
