DIVISION SCHOOLS PRESS CONFERENCE

1. In preparation for the Regional Schools Press Conference to be hosted by Carcar City Division on December 4 - 7, 2016, this Office announces the conduct of the Division Schools Press Conference at the Municipality of Barili on November 15 -18, 2016 with the theme, "Strengthening Freedom of Information through Campus Journalism".
2. Participants to this gathering are the Area Level Top Fifteen Winners in the individual contest categories like newswriting, science and technology writing, editorial writing, feature writing, sports writing, copy reading and headline writing, editorial cartooning and photojournalism, as well as the Top Three Winners in Radio Broadcasting both in English and Filipino categories.
3. They are all required to observe strictly the NSPC guidelines for the different contest categories. Coaches, SPACEPro Officers led by Abegail Villamor and Members of Contest Committees are directed to attend the solidarity meeting at Barili Central School Social Hall at 7:00pm on Day 0 (November 15, 2016).
4. A registration fee of **One Hundred and Fifty Pesos** (Php150.00) shall be charged each participant to defray the cost of contest materials, speakers'/judges' honoraria, sound system, decoration, medals and trophies. Also, a membership fee of **Thirty Pesos** (Php30.00) shall be charged each student writer, while **Sixty Pesos** (Php60.00) membership fee shall be collected from each school paper adviser to defray the cost of speakers'/contest committee members' meals, snacks, contingency and other miscellaneous expenses incurred during the three-day activity.
5. Registration, travel, meals and other expenses incurred by delegates in relation to their participation in the DSPC shall be charged to **School MOOE/SEF/PTA Funds**, subject to their availability and the usual accounting and auditing rules and procedure.
6. This Memorandum shall serve as the Participants' Authority to Travel.
7. Immediate dissemination of and compliance with this Memorandum is hereby directed.
