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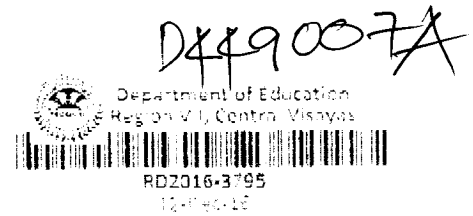

Greetings from Knowledge Channel Foundation Inc. (KCFI)

I would like to inform you that a total of thirty-four (34) schools from your region (17 schools from Bohol and 17 schools from Northern Cebu) have been selected by Sagip Kapamilya to undergo the Learning Effectively through Enhanced Pedagogies Program with Psychological First Aid Training (LEEP-PFA) with the Knowledge Channel Foundation, Inc. (KCFI).

LEEP is a three-day program that seeks to enable the teachers and principals to more effectively operationalize and contextualize K to 12 concepts in classroom sessions using enhanced pedagogies and Knowledge Channel's educational media technologies (installed in an external hard drive which is distributed to each participant-school) for more effective learning. PFA is the most relevant and basic psychosocial support program that helps and assists teachers, principals and learners through a preventive intervention and a sense of efficacy to cope and develop resilience skills following a disaster. At the end of the training program, we envision that the participants will be able to confidently apply their key learning thereby making their classroom sessions more engaging, effective and relevant to the students of the 21<sup>st</sup> century.

We plan to conduct this training for 2 Master Teachers and the Principal of each school enumerated in the document below at any available date from January to March 2017. May we seek your office's support in coordinating with these schools?

In line with this, we respectfully ask for your assistance on the following

1. Securing a list of participants from the Division of Bohol and Division of Northern Cebu - 1 principal and 2 master teachers per school
2. Distribution of the Letter of Agreement (LOA) to the participating schools. This will be sent to the Regional Office via electronic mail
3. Preparation and conduct of the Opening and Closing Program with you or your representative present at both
4. Invitation to stakeholders (community and business leaders, PTA officers, at least 2 per school) for the Stakeholders Session during the last day of training
5. Selection of twenty (20) elementary and twenty (20) secondary students who will participate in the return-demonstration on the last day of the training for each of the patches.
