GRADUATE DIPLOMA IN CULTURAL EDUCATION

To: Schools Division Superintendents

- 1. The National Commission for Culture and the Arts (NCCA), in cooperation with the Department of Education (DepEd), will be implementing the Graduate Diploma in Cultural Education (GDCE) on April May 2017 at the Cebu Normal University.
- 2. The GDCE, a 24-unit graduate credit program follows a two summer ladderized curriculum designed for public school teachers of any subject area in the elementary and high school levels. Each phase consists of 12 graduate-level academic credits. Level 1 scholars are expected to continue to level 2. Successful graduates of program have the option to continue on to the Master of Education, Major in Cultural Education to be offered in Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) selected by NCCA.
- 3. The NCCA shall provide the scholarship grant consisting of full tuition and ₱5,000.00 as stipend to subsidize meals, accommodations, and other expenses.
- 4. All Schools Divisions are encouraged to endorse prospective scholars to Mr. JOSEPH "SONNY" J. CRISTOBAL, Director, Philippine Cultural Education Program.
- 5. Submit the requirements to Dr. Angeline Pogoy, GDCE Project Coordinator at Cebu Normal University, Osmeña Blvd., Cebu City on or before March 20, 2017. See attached enclosure.
