Greetings from Soil and Water Conservation, Inc.!

In a letter dated **Jan. 16, 2017**, I wrote to you about a planned training enhancing the Biodiversity Monitoring System for 43 focal teachers of biodiversity project from the 43 project recipient schools of the province. Planning details have now been finalized.

The following are the details of the activity:

**Training title:** Review for Teachers in Strengthening the Biodiversity Monitoring System (BMS).

Objectives of the training:

\* To sustain and promote the biodiversity monitoring system established in their schools during the implementation of the Biodiversity project.

\*To standardize the BMS reporting system.

\*To standardize the report forms.

\* To level off the skills in species identification.

\* To level off the identification by local names of bird species.

**Training dates:** The training will be done in 3 batches.

1<sup>st</sup> batch – April 21, 22, 23, 2017

2<sup>nd</sup> batch – April 28, 29, 30, 2017

3<sup>rd</sup> batch – May 5, 6, 7, 2017

**Venue:** Nug-as Forest, Alcoy (field work)

Narrapark Resort and Hotel, Lalin Atabay, Alcoy (Lodging and workshop)

**Registration Fee/Transportation Fee:** P800.00 per trainee and transportation cost from residence to assembly area and back. (This is a subsidized rate. This will cover two overnight accommodations in the hotel, meals and the training cost.)

**Training time frame:** The training will start Friday noon and will end after lunch on the following Sunday.

**Requirement:**

- Please bring your own **binocular** and **bird field guide** book and a good pair of walking shoes (The project issued to your school the above two items. You might want to bring a bathing suit for swimming if there is free time after workshops.)
