**AUTHOR: HON. THADEO JOVITO M. OUANO**

**RESPECTFULLY REQUESTING ALL PUBLIC SCHOOLS IN THE PHILIPPINES ESPECIALLY IN CEBU PROVINCE, TO HEED THE CALL OF THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION (DEPED) TO PROMOTE HEALTHY EATING AMONG STUDENTS AND TEACHERS.**

**WHEREAS**, the Department of Education (DepEd) has given public schools nationwide three months to get rid of refrigerators and other facilities bearing the logo of unhealthy foods and drinks, as part of its bid to promote healthy eating among students and teachers;

**WHEREAS**, in a recent order, DepEd has prohibited the marketing of any form of junk foods and beverages in schools and during student activities, which also applies to all DepEd offices;

**WHEREAS**, the prohibition is part of the policy and guidelines on healthy food and beverage choices in schools and all DepEd offices, as outlined in DepEd Order No. 13 issued on March 14;

**WHEREAS**, the policy also bans fat-laden, sugary and salty foods and drinks in the canteens of all public elementary and high schools, and DepEd offices in Region VII;

**WHEREAS**, to regulate the sale of unhealthy foods, the order identified typical forms of marketing of unhealthy foods and drinks that will no longer be allowed in schools;

**WHEREAS**, these include advertising through branded vending machines, refrigerators and ice boxes; signs in school canteens and sports facilities; sponsorship of sports events and school programs; and promotion through celebrity endorsements and price discounts or vouchers as educational rewards;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, on motion of Majority Floor Leader, **Hon. JUDE THADDEUS DURANO SYBICO**, duly seconded by Assistant Majority Floor Leader, **Hon. CHRISTOPHER R. BARICUATRO**, for the approval of the resolution authored by Member, **Hon. THADEO JOVITO M. OUANO**, be it

**RESOLVED**, as it is hereby **RESOLVED**, to respectfully request all Public Schools in the Philippines especially in Cebu Province, to heed the call of the Department of Education (DepEd) to promote healthy eating among students and teachers;

**RESOLVED FINALLY**, to furnish copies of this Resolution to Governor Hilario P. Davide III, all Municipal and City Mayors and Public Schools in the Province of Cebu, for their information and appropriate action.

**WHEREAS**, it is the policy of the State to protect and promote the right to health of the people and instill health consciousness among them;

**WHEREAS**, to promote a healthy diet and positive eating behavior and provide healthy eating environment to learners and to their teaching and non-teaching personnel, the Department of Education (DepEd) has issued guidelines on healthy food and beverage choices in school and in its offices;

**WHEREAS**, the policy and guidelines aim to: make available healthier food and beverage choices among the learners and DepEd personnel and their stakeholders; introduce a system of categorizing locally available foods and drinks in accordance with geographical, cultural, and religious orientations; provide guidance in evaluating and categorizing foods and drinks; and provide guidance in the selling and marketing of foods and beverages in schools and DepEd offices, including the purchasing of foods for school feeding;

**WHEREAS**, violators of the said order shall be dealt administratively pursuant to its existing rules and procedures on administrative cases;


