**FIRST CYCLE OF TRAINING FOR READING REMEDIATION SUPPORT PROGRAM (RRSP):  
SUPPORTING TEACHERS IN ASSISTING READERS TRAINING (START)**

1. DepEd-USAID's *Basa Pilipinas* will run the **First Cycle of Training for the Reading Remediation Support Program (RRSP): Supporting Teachers in Assisting Readers Training (START)** on July 22-26, 2017 at Corner F. Cabahug and President Quezon Streets, Mabolo, Cebu City.
2. Please refer to the attached List of Participants.
3. This training aims to prepare participants for the implementation of the pilot remediation program by orienting them with the framework of RRSP, and equipping them with skills necessary in the conduct of reading remediation.
4. Please take note of the following:
  - Bantayan participants can check in on July 21 while the rest of the participants will check in on July 22. Check out is on July 26, 2017;
  - Registration will start at 7:30 AM and Opening Program will start at 8:00 AM of July 22, 2017;
  - Teacher-participants are advised to bring samples of the formative assessment they constructed for Quarter 1 of the current school year in Mother Tongue and Filipino;
  - Grade 1 teachers are advised to bring any two booklets of Mother Tongue Leveled Readers (Relatively Easy) for Quarter 2 to Quarter 4; and
  - Grade 2 teachers will also bring any two booklets of Filipino Leveled Readers (Relatively Easy).
5. Teaching personnel shall be granted **Service Credits** tantamount to the number of days rendered during non-school day/s, as reflected in the daily attendance sheets, while non-teaching personnel are entitled to a **Compensatory Time Off (CTO)** benefit for their involvement in the said training during non-working days.
6. Traveling, hotel accommodation, meals, snacks and other expenses relative thereto, shall be chargeable against **USAID Basa Pilipinas Funds**, subject to availability and the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
7. This Memorandum serves as Authority to Travel.
8. Immediate dissemination of and compliance with this Memorandum is directed.

Greetings! I hope this email finds you well.


