**LIVE-IN DIVISION TRAINING OF TRAINERS IN MUSIC EDUCATION**

1. This Office announces the conduct of a Live-In Division Training of Trainers in Music Education from September 18-21, 2017 at DepEd Ecotech Center Pavilion, Sudlon, Lahug, Cebu City.

2. The training aims to realize the following objectives:


- a. Organize Division Pool of Trainers in Music to help provide technical assistance to teachers teaching Music in both Elementary and Secondary;
- b. Contextualize and indigenize instruments and topics in the curriculum guide;
- c. Trainers and trainees use and play any musical instrument they know of;
- d. Cascade the training in their own school/district.

3. Attention is invited to this item for the number of participants per district, to wit:

<p>From the 55 Schools Districts in the Elementary, Each district <b>must</b> send two (2) best teachers in Music from any grade level (Grades 1-3, 4-6) who have the following qualifications:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Must know how to play any musical instrument (e.g. ukulele, bamboo flute, guitar, violin, keyboard, etc.)</li> <li>• Must at least have good oral communication skills;</li> <li>• Must possess right attitude (attitude over skill/s)</li> </ul>	<p>From the 44 Municipalities, each Municipality must send 2 best teachers teaching Music selected from any grade level (grades 7-10) possessing the following qualifications:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Must know how to play any musical instrument fitted for high school learners (e.g. guitar, drums, flute, keyboard, violin , etc.)</li> <li>• Must at least have good oral communication skills;</li> <li>• Must possess right attitude (attitude over skill/s)</li> </ul>
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4. All participants are required to bring their own musical instrument/s, and laptop.
5. The training shall start at 9:00 o'clock in the morning of September 18, 2017. All participants are required to be in the venue on or before the set time to observe punctuality.
6. All PSDSs are directed to ensure that District/s and the secondary schools under their responsibility are represented. Attendance to this training is a **Must**.
7. A registration fee of **Four Thousand Eight Hundred Pesos (Php 4,800.00)** each participant, inclusive of food and accommodation for four (4) days, shall be collected.
8. Trainers and Resource Speakers whose names are enclosed hereto are expected to check in on September 16, 2017 to attend the session on Facilitation Skills for Facilitators.
- 9.. This Memorandum serves as Authority to Travel of the participants.
10. Registration fee, traveling and other incidental expenses incurred by the participants in their attendance to this training shall be chargeable against Local School MOOE, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
