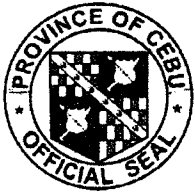

1. This Office announces the participation of Cebu Province in the Batang Pinoy Visayas Qualifying Leg organized by the Philippine Sports Commission together with the Philippine Olympic Committee and supported by the Department of Education on November 10-16, 2017 at Dumaguete City.
2. All School Heads who have athletes involved in the Batang Pinoy are directed to submit the following:
 - Alternative Delivery Mode (ADM) for athletes to compensate the classes not attended;
 - Parent's permit (signed by both father and mother)
 - Arrangement of classes of coaches and delegates to ensure that their classes are well-taken care of.
3. Attached hereto is the list of participants for Cebu Province Delegation coming from the Cebu Sports Commission for the perusal of all concern School Heads.
4. Those Districts with Batang Pinoy delegates who are endorsed by their Municipal Mayor and funded by their LGU are directed to submit the same requirements to this Office.
5. Expenses incurred by the identified Batang Pinoy delegates shall be shouldered by the Cebu Provincial Sports Commission, subject to the existing accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
6. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.

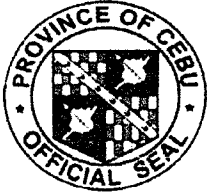
