

Greetings from the Science Clubbing Movement

The Pambansang Kapisanan ng mga Kabataan Samahan sa Agham (PSYSC), Inc. is the first and largest science club umbrella organization in the Philippines. For 46 years, PSYSC remains to be the frontrunner of the Science Clubbing Movement in the country conducting workshops, lectures, and activities that provide alternative learning experience among elementary and secondary science clubbers. With this, PSYSC continues to develop a community geared towards scientific learning and innovation, while also emphasizing the roles of science clubs in nation building and in promoting the thrust of the organization - the Public Understanding of Science, Technology, and Environment (PUSTE).

In an effort to recognize the endeavors of science clubs and to further empower their members, PSYSC holds The Annual Search for the Most Quistanding Science Club (SEARCH). It is composed of two major events: the SEARCH Competition and the SEARCH Convention.

The SEARCH Competition has the goal of finding and recognizing the best science clubs of the country with the most innovative project that addresses the salient issues of today. It is screened through four levels, with the following criteria: (1) Main Project, (2) STE Activities, (3) Multi-Sectoral Support, (4) Presentation, and (5) Public Recognition and Prominence. This year, more than 50 elementary and secondary level science clubs around the country are vying for the grand title: being the Most Outstanding Science Club. Full guidelines for the SEARCH Competition 2017 are posted and can be accessed on our Facebook page: www.tacebook.com/psysc.search. Participating science clubs are required to submit a project report on December 9, 2017 while the deadline for submission of final portfolios is on January 19, 2018.

The SEARCH Convention 2018, will be a two-day gathering of science clubbers and teachers from elementary to senior high school which will be held at the University of the Philippines, Dilimen, Quezon City on April 6-7, 2017. This year's theme.
